














A HUB OF ACTIVITY



MUST SEES

From training to battle, discover the strength of our nation's soldiers through their stories at the U.S. Army Heritage & Education Center, an interactive museum with indoor and outdoor exhibits. Find details on page 13 of the Directory side.

Take a stroll on the **Army Heritage Trail's** one-mile path,
surrounded by a memorial garden,
full-scale interactive exhibits and
equipment appealing to all ages.
You'll see everything from the French
and Indian War era to present

Dive into the county's history at the Cumberland County Historical Society and discover the past 250 years at the library and exhibits. At this impressive museum, learn stories about the Carlisle Indian School and famed wood carver William Schimmel. Take time to browse folk art and decorative art galleries. All aboard! Four 19thcentury buildings preserved by the Mechanicsburg Museum are open for tours - including The Stationmaster's House, Frankenberger Tavern, The Freight Station and Passenger Station. Find details on page 28 of the Directory side.



Stop to see one of the oldest Army posts in the United States, the Carlisle Barracks. Its unique history includes operating as the Carlisle Indian School from 1879-1918. During that time, famed athlete Jim Thorpe attended the school. The Barracks is now part of the U.S. Army War College and is open to self-guided tours during the day. Find details and instructions for getting on base on page 11 of the Directory side.

Stand by the monument of one of the Revolutionary War's bravest women, Molly Pitcher (Molly Ludwig Hays McCauley), on the grounds of Carlisle's Old Public Graveyard. Take a peek behind the monument for Molly's actual grave, marked with an 1876 grave marker. Find details on page 11 of the Directory side.



Take a seat in the Historic Peace Church and transport to a time where the colonial wine glass pulpit and 200-year-old organ were used on a regular basis in the community. Once occupied by the Confederate Army during the Civil War, the church is now open for weddings, special services and free lawn concerts. Find details on page 7 of the Directory side.



Get out your camera for a photo-op at the oldest standing mill structure in this region, the Laughlin Mill. Make sure to bring some bread for the local wildlife at this scenic backdrop. Find details on page 39 of the Directory side.

Pick out a few books at Civil War and More and take this part of history home with you. You'll find everything you need to know about the 1863 invasion of Pennsylvania in this quaint Mechanicsburg store. Don't hesitate to utilize the staff's endless knowledge of local Civil War trivia and allow them to point you in the direction of nearby historic landmarks. Kids will love to see an old-fashioned fire truck at the Union Fire Co. 1 Museum. dedicated to the oldest volunteer company still operating in Pennsylvania. Housed in a restored Victorian building, the two-story museum is home to a 1929 fire engine and firefighting artifacts dating back to the creation of the company. HOW TO GET STARTED ON YOUR FISHING JOURNEY

Make sure to take a few minutes to obtain a fishing license and/or launch permit and read over fishing and boating regulations before starting your trip. Visit fishandboat.com for information on boat registration, fishing license, water trails and more! You can purchase a fishing license online (fishandboat. com) by mail, or in person at K-Mart Stores in Carlisle, Enola and Mechanicsbura. or Wal-Mart Stores in Carlisle, Mechanicsburg and Shippensburg.



Steeped in natural and historical features, the 696-acre Pine Grove Furnace State Park is in a beautiful mountain setting in southern Cumberland Valley. Pine Grove Furnace features two lakes, 25-acre Laurel Lake and 1.7-acre Fuller Lake, a historic area and the Appalachian Trail. Park amenities include: 4 miles of Hiking Trails, Biking, Picnic Tables/

Pavilions, Swimming, Snack Bar, Boating (electric motors only), Fishing, Hunting, Dog Training, Ice-Skating, Cross-Country Skiing, Snowmobiling, Camping, Organized Group Tenting, and Cabin Rental. The Appalachian Trail Museum and historic Ironmaster's Mansion are also located here. Find more details on page 14 of the Directory side.

Gifford Pinchot State Park - Lewisberry, PA Wildwood Park – Harrisburg, PA Little Buffalo State Park - Newport, PA Caledonia State Park - Fayetteville, PA



Sitting astride South Mountain in southern Cumberland Valley, Kings Gap Environmental Education Center offers a panoramic view of the valley. The park consists of 2,531 acres of forest and is open to the public year-round from 8am to sunset. Trails connect with three main day use areas: Pine Plantation Day Use Area, Pond Day Use Area and Mansion Day Use Area. Park amenities include: 16 miles of Hiking Trails, Picnic Tables/ Pavilions, Orienteering, Hunting, Dog Training, Biking, Environmental Education Programs, Seasonal Concerts, Gardens, Parking, and Bird Watching. Colonel Denning State Park, in north central Cumberland Valley, is in Doubling Gap, so named by the "S" turn where Blue Mountain doubles back on itself. This feature may be seen from the Doubling Gap Vista in adjacent Tuscarora State Forest. The park has 273 acres of woodland and a 3.5acre lake. Park amenities include: 18 miles of Hiking Trails with 3.5 miles in the park, Equestrian Trail, Picnic Tables/Pavilions, Swimming, Orienteering, Fishing, Hunting, Dog Training, Ice-Skating, Cross-Country Skiing, Camping, and Organized Group Tenting. Find more details on page 40 of the Directory side.

The Valley's landscape offers beautiful vistas and scenic views. In the fall months, make the short hike to Waggoner's Gap Hawk Watch for views of the Valley and the hawk migration. Families will enjoy Pole Steeple's .75-mile climb to a quartzite rock outcropping or, for a challenge, take on Flat Rock's 2.5-mile rugged hike to a 180-degree view from atop a natural rock outcrop. Enjoy a leisurely afternoon at Negley Park in Lemoyne with a skyline view of Harrisburg. Find the Top 10 hikes at visitcumberlandvalley.com/10hikes.

Home to the Conodoguinet Creek Water Trail, Yellow Breeches Creek Water Trail and the Susquehanna River, the Valley offers a variety of kayaking and canoeing opportunities down calming waters. You can also enjoy the scenic Children's Lake by shallow-draft or electric motor boat. Don't have your own boat? You can rent one at Susquehanna Outfitters or Blue Mountain Outfitters. Pine Grove Furnace State Park also has kayak, canoe and paddle boat rentals available for Laurel Lake (seasonal). Find more info at visitcumberlandvalley.com/boating.




Cumberland Valley is a flyfisher's paradise with three of the world's most popular fly-fishing destinations—LeTort Spring Run, Yellow Breeches Creek and Big Spring Creek Greenway. Beginners will enjoy the catch-and-release sections at Yellow Breeches and Big Spring, while those looking for a challenge can try their skills at LeTort. If you'd like a lesson, start with Tom's Fly Fishing Service or the Fly Fishing School at Allenberry. Find more info at visitcumberlandvalley.com/flyfishing.

Bikers can get moving on the Valley's scenic trails and in our charming downtowns. Enjoy a leisurely ride on the 11-mile Cumberland Valley Rail Trail or explore the historic and bike-friendly town of Carlisle to uncover museums, art galleries, dining and more. If you're traveling and don't want to bring the bikes, you can rent them at Holmes Cycling & Fitness. Find detailed routes at visitcumberlandvalley.com/bikeroutes.

The Valley's woodlands and fields make spotting common game species like deer, squirrel and turkey easy. Whether you're a hunter or a wildlife watcher you can enjoy the Valley's rich habitats including our three state parks, two state forests and three state game lands. Boiling Springs is recognized as an official Appalachian Trail Community for the town's commitment to providing a service to hikers & promoting the assets of the Appalachian Trail. Parking lot located on Bucher Hill Rd., Boiling Springs, 17007


Portable toilet available in large gravel lot. Follow the AT blazes across Bucher Hill Road, along the famous fly-fishing stream Yellow Breeches Creek, then along Children's Lake. Continue past the gazebo to the ATC. You can also head south on the AT, crossing a beautiful historic stone bridge, zig zagging through farm fields & taking a steady climb up South Mountain to Center Point Knob, the original midway point of the trail. The large holes you pass are from iron ore mining for the foundry located in the parking lot.

A Ironmaster's Mansion 1212 Pine Grove Rd, Gardners, 17324 717-486-4108 • ironmastersmansion.com The newly renovated Ironmaster's Mansion serves as a hostel for AT hikers. Continue south to see the promi-

nent marker showing the actual midway point of the A.T.


5 Pine Grove Furnace State Park 1100 Pine Grove Rd, Gardners, 17324 717-486-7174 • dcnr.state.pa.us/stateparks/ findapark/pinegrovefurnace Various parking lots are located in the park. Visit the AT Museum then follow the white blazes south, past the General Store. This is where thru-hikers stop to celebrate reaching the midway point of the trail by eating a half gallon of ice cream.

Scott Farm Appalachian Trail Work Center 314 Bernheisel Bridge Rd, Carlisle, 17015 Parking, water spigot & portable toilet are available at this site. Cross the bridge on the pedestrian walkway to head south on the A.T. White blazes lead the way; double blazes indicates a turn or prominent landmark. Continue left into the woods along a wooden boardwalk. Hike until you are ready to return to your vehicle. For an alternative hike, turn right & follow the trail along Conodoguinet Creek.



UNCOVER CULTURAL GEMS

Treat yourself to the art world located throughout the Valley. Historic theatres and live productions are plentiful in our small communities. Cruise down the Susquehanna River to live music or take a drive through covered bridges surrounded by a charming rural landscape.



Navigate a winding, scenic route with the **Covered Bridge & Wine Loop**. Choose between a shorter or longer trip around nearby covered bridges and wineries. Both trips end at the Carlisle Fairgrounds, making it a perfect addition to a car show weekend.

- Loop A is a total of 86.7
 miles and covers seven
 bridges throughout your
 journey.
- Loop B is a total of 144.5 miles, an all day excursion covering eight bridges and three wineries.
