

Every 4 years 10 medal Alpine 70+ countries




Every 2 years

WORLD CUP

Annual international series 25-30 nations compete 24 resorts host around the world 1-2 sites in the US

- Economic impact \$120 million++
- On site spectators: 15,000/race





HOW TO GET TO THE RACES





ARRIVE ONE HOUR EARLY

Gates open at 8:00 AM. Avoid long lines, get the best seats, & enjoy all our pre-race festivities: Vendor Village, Concessions, Live Entertainment including Cheerleaders, Marching Bands, Mascots and much more!



FREE BUS

Buses leave from regular stops in Vail, Avon and Beaver Creek every 5-15 Minutes. For information on routes and schedules go to: vailbeavercreek2015.com/getting-around



PARKING

From East, use Exit 168 and follow signs to Rodeo Lot. From West, park at Arrowhead or follow signs to Big Bear or Rodeo Lots. BC Village parking will be closed to the public.

SKI



- From Beaver Creek Village, take Centennial (Chair 6) up and ski Red Tail down to the race finish.
- From The Westin Gondola, take Chair 15 then 18. Follow signs to Larkspur Bowl which will lead you to Red Tail Stadium.
- From Arrowhead, ski over to Bachelor Gulch and take either Chair 16 or 18 and follow signs to Red Tail Stadium



WALK

Walk or snowshoe Trail '15 (aka Dally) from BC Village. No showshoes? No problem. Demo a pair from the Atlas Snowshoe Tent. Allow for approximately 20 - 40 minutes uphill and 8-15 minutes downhill.


