STEP BACK IN TIME.

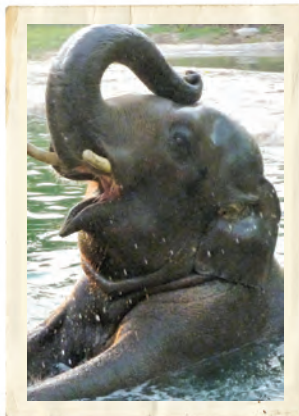

ENJOY URBAN ADVENTURES.

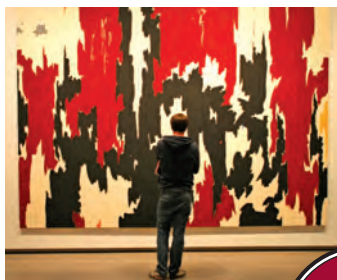
