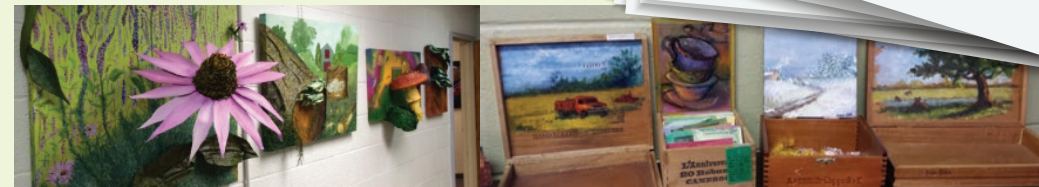
Art Sanctuary

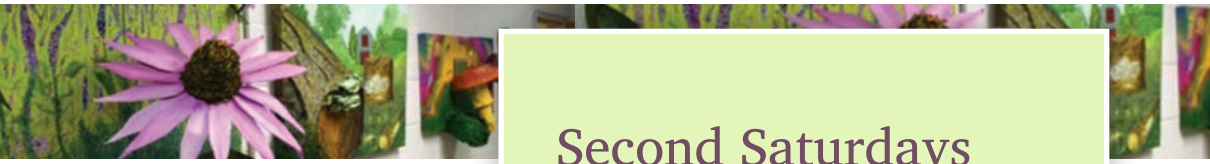
